The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 6, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 6, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when he or she: in a public place and with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof: engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; make unreasonable noise; or refuses to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard, or other emergency; or creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate purpose or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 6, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally placed another person in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:


The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 6, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant escapes from custody or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:


