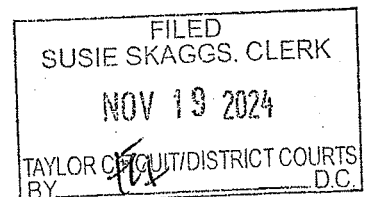

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 2020, through June 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor (NM) to engage in: Illegal Sexual activity; or Illegal controlled substances activity other than activity involving marijuana or salvia, as defined in KRS 218A.010; or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



COUNTS 7-9 :

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 2020, through June 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor (EM) to engage in: Illegal Sexual activity; or Illegal controlled substances activity other than activity involving marijuana or salvia, as defined in KRS 218A.010; or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 10-14 :

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 2020 through June 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally caused serious physical injury to another person (NM); or he intentionally causes physical injury to another person by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument; or wantonly causes serious physical injury to another person by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 15 :

The Grand Jury charges that on or about July 2020 through June 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, **in a continuous course of conduct, no less than two times**, subjects to sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person (NM) to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated or an individual with an intellectual disability; or being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he subjects another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate; or being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 16 :

The Grand Jury charges that on or about July 2020, through June 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, **in a continuous course of conduct, no less than two times**, subjects to sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person (EM) to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated or an individual with an intellectual disability; or being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he subjects another person who is less

than sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate; or being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 17 :

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 2020, through June 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he/she wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 5, 2024, through October 7, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly possessed or used any current or former identifying information of another person or family member or ancestor of the other person such as that person's or family member's or ancestor's name, address, telephone number, electronic mail address, Social Security number, driver's license number, birth date, personal identification number or code, and any other information which could be used to identify the person, including unique biometric data, with the intent to represent that he or she is the other person for the purpose of: depriving that other person of property; obtaining benefits or property to which he or she would otherwise not be entitled; making financial or credit transactions using the other person's identity; avoiding detection; or commercial or political benefit or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 5, 2024, through October 7, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant shall have his or her license in his or her immediate possession at all times when driving a motor vehicle and shall display it upon demand to the circuit clerk or examiner, a peace officer, a member of the Department of Kentucky State Police or a field deputy or inspector of the Department of Vehicle Regulation or Transportation Cabinet or, pursuant to KRS67A.075 or 83A.088. a safety officer who is in the process of securing information to complete an accident report or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 5, 2024, through October 7, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to maintain required insurance or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 5, 2024, through October 7, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection

(12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 5, 2024, through October 7, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant after applying for or receiving an operator's license, moves from the address named in the application or license issued to him or when the name of a license is changed, by marriage or otherwise, the person shall within ten (10) days after the change apply to the circuit clerk in his county of residence for the issuance of a corrected license or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 5, 2024, through October 7, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear a seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:


