The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 2024, through August 3, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant it shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly use a communications system, including computers, computer networks, computer bulletin boards, cellular telephones, or any other electronic means, for the purpose of: (a) Procuring or promoting the use of a minor, including a peace officer, or a person working in coordination with law enforcement, posing as a minor if the person believes that the peace officer or the person working in coordination with law enforcement is a minor or is wanton or reckless in that belief; or (b) Procuring or promoting the use of a minor from an adult intermediary, including a peace officer, or a person working in coordination with law enforcement, posing as an adult intermediary for a minor if the person believes that the peace officer or the person working in coordination with law enforcement is an adult intermediary for a minor or is wanton or reckless in that belief; for any activity in violation of KRS 510.040, 510.050, 510.060, 510.070, 510.080, 510.090, 510.110, 529.100 where that offense involves commercial sexual activity, or

530.064(1)(a), or KRS Chapter 531. (2) No person shall be convicted of this offense and an offense specified in KRS 506.010, 506.030, 506.040, or 506.080 for a single course of conduct intended to consummate in the commission of the same offense with the same minor or peace officer. (3) Each day a person knowingly uses a communications system for the purpose of procuring or promoting the use of a minor shall be a separate violation of this section. (4) The solicitation of a minor through electronic communication under subsection (1) of this section shall be prima facie evidence of the person's intent to commit the offense, and the offense is complete at that point without regard to whether the person met or attempted to meet the minor. (5) This section shall apply to electronic communications originating within or received within the Commonwealth or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNTS 11-20**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 2024, through August 3, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant: acting other than as a retail licensee, he knowingly sells, gives, purchases or procures any alcoholic or malt beverage in any form to or for a minor; knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor to engage in any other criminal activity; knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor to become a habitual truant; or persistently and knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor to disobey his parent or guardian or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNTS 21-30**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 2024 through August 3, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant he or she subjects another person to sexual contact without the latter's consent or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 2:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 3:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possess a controlled substance classified in Schedules IV or V or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. **COUNT 4:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant to whom or for whose use any controlled substance has been prescribed, sold or dispensed, by a practitioner or other person authorized under this chapter, may lawfully possess it only in the container in which it was delivered to him/her by the person selling or dispensing the same or abetted or counseled with another in commission of said act. The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 7:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear a seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted, or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 8:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to produce written proof in the form of an insurance card that the insured has in effect an insurance contract providing security in conformity with this subtitle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.
