Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 3:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about December 21, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state:

having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 4:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 21, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to have the child properly secured in a child restraint system of a type meeting federal motor vehicle safety standards or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 2023, through July, 2023, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant subjects to sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated or an individual with an intellectual disability; or being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he subjects another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate; or being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.


**COUNT 9:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June, 2023, through July 2023, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant: acting other than as a retail licensee, he knowingly sells, gives, purchases or procures any alcoholic or malt beverage in any form to or for a minor; knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor to engage in any other criminal activity; knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor to become a habitual truant; or persistently and knowingly induces, assists, or causes a minor to disobey his parent or guardian or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. 
