The Grand Jury charges that on or about February 8, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 2:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 8, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant shall not operate or be in physical control of a motor vehicle while his or her license is revoked or suspended under this chapter, or upon the conclusion of a license revocation period pursuant to KRS 189A.340 unless the person has his or her valid ignition interlock license in the person's possession and the motor vehicle or motorcycle is equipped with a functioning ignition interlock device as required by KRS 189A.420 or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. 
